Environmental Issues – Climate Change



2CL are learning about the environment and climate change in our science lessons.

Investigating is always fun, but adding some Lego makes it colourful fun with blocks.

We decided to build Lego structures as we felt we needed to make something that we could place ice in and observe it as it melted. Lego is a great material as it is easy to make simple and complex structures quickly.



First, we predicted in which environment the ice would melt more quickly. What do you think?

Then, we built Lego houses, carefully put the ice in, covered it, and started the timer to see how long the ice would take to melt in each environment.



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To find out how climate change is happening, we conducted a comparative test. Using ice, we wanted to compare how covering the Lego traps the heat and warms up the atmosphere. This mirrors the effect the greenhouse gases have in our atmosphere.
