Communication

At which time the teachers will contact you when they have an opportunity. Likewise, teachers will contact you with updates, letters and if there is important information you require.

Morning Routines

Thank you for continuing to adhere to the allocated arrival times and using the correct gates. Please be reminded that whilst the children's temperatures are being checked you are required to wait until indicated that everything is normal. If another adult brings your child to school please ensure they are also aware of this protocol and they wait until they receive a signal that your child has been checked and all is satisfactory.

Clothing

As part of the child development process to build independence and confidence we encourage the children to dress themselves independently between transitions and in preparation for certain activities. We always check the children to ensure they are dressed appropriately and ready for their activities. To support this development we ask that you also provide similar opportunities and encourage your child with these tasks.

Finally, to help with the identification of your child's school uniform we ask that you please label your child's clothes clearly. This helps to reduce unnecessary stress when children cannot find their belongings.
